

**TAX TIPS FOR CIRCUS
EXHIBITOR
CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN DELAWARE**

Things You Should Know

Definitions *30, Del. C., Ch. 23*

A circus exhibitor is every person engaged in the business of exhibiting in a tent, arena, or other open space feats of horsemanship, acrobatic stunts, freaks, trained or wild animals, and other forms of entertainment commonly known as circus.

Gross Receipts

A circus exhibitor is exempt from the gross receipts tax.

License and Gross Receipts Requirements

A circus exhibitor is required to obtain a business license for a fee of \$750 which must be renewed annually on or before December 31st of each year. If the circus or carnival is for private profit sponsored by or in which any fire company of the State, or any fraternal, veteran's or religious organization shares in the profits, the license fee is \$300. To register with the Division of Revenue and obtain a business license, please complete a Combined Registration Application, available on the Internet, and mail to the Division of Revenue with the appropriate fee.

Regulatory and Local Requirements

The Business License Issued by the Division of Revenue is not a regulatory license and the issuance of such license does not attest to the qualifications of the applicant to perform the activity described on such license. Many local jurisdictions have requirements for a business license and may have restrictions concerning the locations of conducting the referenced business activity. Please check with the local government office in the town, city or county in which you will conduct your business.

The State of Delaware also has a Division of Professional Regulations. Many occupations and some types of equipment have regulatory requirements. Please contact the Division of Professional Regulation for more information.
